Teamwork makes the dream work!

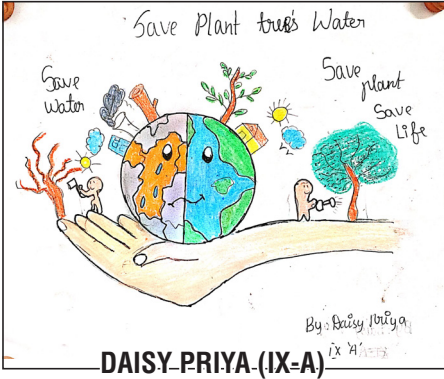

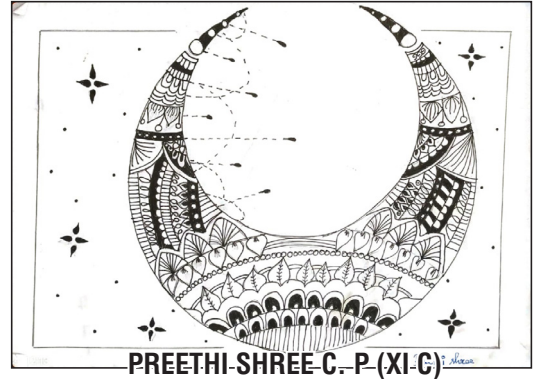




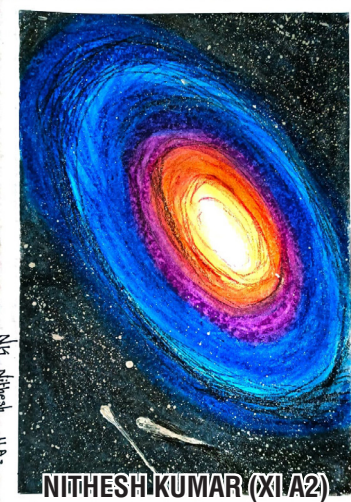

Death's gentle touch draws nigh.

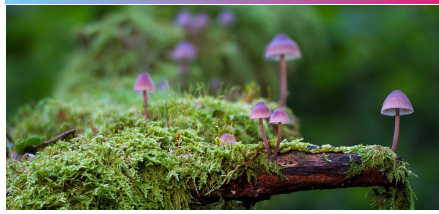
Yet fear not the embrace of night,

Martyrdom of Vanchinathan

The Indian freedom movement in 1911 was part of a series of ongoing efforts to gain independence from British colonial rule. This period was characterized by a mix of constitutional and radical approaches to achieve self-governance.

In the early 1900s, the atmosphere in India was charged with revolutionary fervor, especially in Bengal and Maharashtra. Inspired by these movements, Vanchinathan joined the Bharatha Matha Association, a secret revolutionary society that aimed to overthrow British rule through violent means if necessary. The association, founded by Neelakanta Brahmachari, sought to instill a sense of patriotism and sacrifice among its members.

Assassination of Robert Ashe

The event that brought Vanchinathan to national attention was his assassination of Robert Ashe, the British Collector of Tirunelveli. Ashe was seen as a symbol of British oppression and had taken strong measures against the Swadeshi Movement and revolutionary activities in the region. On June 17, 1911, Vanchinathan, along with his associate Sankara Krishna Iyer, waited at the Maniyachi railway junction (now Vanchi Maniyachchi) for Ashe's train. When Ashe arrived, Vanchi approached him and shot him at point-blank range, killing him instantly. Immediately after the assassination, Vanchinathan ran to a nearby lavatory and shot himself, choosing to die rather than be captured by the British authorities.

Legacy of Vanchinathan

Vanchinathan left behind a note in his pocket, explaining his actions and expressing his desire for India's freedom.

The note read after the sacrifice of Vanchinathan: *"I dedicate my life as a small contribution to my motherland. I am alone responsible for this. I sincerely request the next of kin to forgive me for my action. Vande Mataram."*

Vanchinathan's act of assassination was a significant event in the history of the Indian freedom struggle. It highlighted the growing radicalism among Indian youth and the willingness to use violent means to achieve independence. His sacrifice became a symbol of the intense desire for freedom and inspired many others to join the revolutionary movement.

Commemoration

In memory of his sacrifice, the railway station where the assassination took place was renamed Vanchi Maniyachchi Junction. Vanchinathan is remembered as a martyr who gave his life for the cause of India's independence, and his story continues to inspire future generations of Indians in their pursuit of justice and freedom.

Vanchinathan's sacrifice teaches several important life skills and values:

Commitment, Courage and Bravery, Selflessness, Responsibility, Inspiration and Influence and above all Patriotism and Love for One's Country as the citizen we must stick to the spark lighten by our freedom fighters to keep our country strong, united, and continually progressing towards justice, equality, and prosperity for all.

Example sentence: "The university's orientation program helps international students start on the right foot in their academic and cultural adjustment."



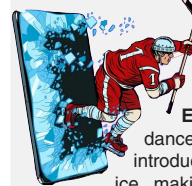
"Launch a new chapter"
